ACTIVATION OF XP

- □ PRODUCT KEY CHANGE AND ACTIVATION OF XP
 - □ XP Home or XP Pro
 - □ Make sure the PC is online to the internet.
 - □ Load the KeyUpdateTool_enu.exe program (from Microsoft) and input the Product Key from the COA Sticker.
 - □ Reboot, this will change the Key and Activate at the same time.
 - □ XP mce (Media Center Edition): for XP mce you must use the telephone trick shown on the next page to change the Key. Then click in the Sytem tray to Activate Online
 - □ Reboot again to make sure all comes up clean.

ACTIVATION PROBLEMS

- □ IF YOU ARE FORCED TO ACTIVATE BEFORE WINDOWS LOGON: If Windows will not log-on because of a need to activate, then:
 - 1. Click "Activate now".
 - 2. Click "Yes, I want to Telephone.....", <Next>
 - 3. Click "Change Product Key", <Next>
 - 4. Enter the Product key from the COA sticker and click <Update>
 - 5. Click "Remind me later",
 - 6. Reboot, XP should logon now and give you time to activate.
 - ✓ PRODUCT KEY PROBLEMS:
 - Some older Product Keys are not accepted by newer XP install images
 - If the key just will not work and you are able to boot the newly installed image. Hook the PC up to the internet and try the **KeyUpdateTool_enu.exe** program from Microsoft to put in the Key shown on the COA Sticker.
 - Worst case, you could do a Windows Repair Install and it will let you put in the correct Key.
 - NOTES:
 - Change Product Key with Keyfinder 1.5b.
 - If Keyfinder or the technique above will not change the Key, then you probably have the wrong version of XP installed and possibly need an OEM version. See: (*Right-click My Computer > Properities > General Tab*) and find the "Registered to" value: xxxxx-OEM-zzzzzz-zzzz.
 - On the install CD, see the CD "i386\setupp.ini file. The best PID entry should end with nnnnnOEM, not nnnnn000.
 - Do a "regedit" and search for the Key shown in the System Properties. You will find it in three places. Change all three ID fields (ProductID, PID) MPC&CID values to match your install CD or match the value from the old installation (Belarc Advisor). ie: Sys properties shows = 76487-OEM, CD or old install shows 55274-008. Then Reboot. Go

back to ACTIVATE above.
